Dear Mr. McIver:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that if you continue to communicate false accusations against Mr. Seckel or in any other manner attempt to intermeddle in his social or employment relations with others, this firm will institute a lawsuit against you for the recovery of substantial monetary damages.
