

reveal the hidden constraints of the perceptual system in a way that
normal perceptual processes do not. In this lecture, Seckel will
present an incredible variety of powerful and surprising illusions,
many not seen before, which reveal important insights into how we
construct an accurate mental representation of our external world.

A Seckel, a Research Fellow, in the Division of Computational and Neuronal Systems, at the California Institute of Technology, is among the world's leading experts in visual and other types of sensory illusions. He has already published several popular collections of illusions, and is currently finishing a comprehensive academic treatise for MIT Press.
